Chapter 3

A Fortunate Occurrence

Start of Eldred High School, 1925–1926

The year before I completed grammar school, a high school was built in our town. Without this fortunate occurrence, my education would probably have ceased at the grammar school level.—Arthur Austin.

The Orchard Terrace Boarding House, which once belonged to Abel Myers, was being remodeled into the new high school in 1925. Arthur and his brother Bob could keep track of the construction progress on the new school on their way to and from the old one.

In the fall of 1925 Art would begin the eighth grade (his last year of grammar school) at the new school.

While Art and Bob attended school, their brother Bill helped out their dad. Besides the work of running a boarding house and growing a garden, Mort did side jobs such as drawing wood for neighbors, haying, clearing brush, or gardening.

Raymond Austin seems to be working at a Barge Office (possibly under the direction of the Coast Guard) in New York City. He lived on Staten Island and corresponded with Gladys Myers. Raymond's family often wrote him. But he does not keep in touch by letter often enough for his mother Jennie.

Lillie Austin Calkin, the only

Austin cousin of Raymond, Bill, Art, and Bob, attended College and taught in New Paltz, New York.

In 1925 Lillie, 41, her husband Burt (a carpenter), their children Dorothy (Dot) and Dale, and Emma Austin (Lillie's mother) lived in New Paltz until Easter break. Burt and Dale then went home and tended their farm in Bethel, New York. Lillie and her children continued to exchange letters with Lillie's father, James Eldred Austin (Uncle Ell).

Lillie Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y., to J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.


January 3, 1925 Dear Dad,

All are well except Dorothy who has sore eyes, pink eye, I guess. She is getting better. With love, Lillie

Bob Austin, Eldred, to Raymond Austin, Staten Island

February 9, 1925 Raymond,

The snow up here is melting fast. In the morning it is frozen so we go sleigh riding. We both got

sleighs for Christmas. We saw the total eclipse of the sun. We have our wood sawed. Mrs. Cox hurt her leg sleigh riding and she came to school with a cane.

I am sick and I can not go to school. I had to stay in bed all day Sunday. I felt dizzy when I stood up. I hope you are feeling well. I am feeling better.

I hope you can come up on Lincoln's birthday. The rest of the family are feeling well. Arthur is as fat as ever.

In the letters of Lillie Calkin in the rest of this chapter, she often mentions Hannah Calkin, her sister-in-law, the current health status in their family, the weather, her teaching, their garden, and an update on their hens and eggs. A number of folks sold eggs as a source of income (including Garfield and Ella Leavenworth, who we will read more about later).

Lillie Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y., to J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.

January 21, 1925 Dear Dad,

Hope you are well. Mother has been very sick. Grippe and pleurisy. She is around now.

Hannah came a week ago

Saturday. The children and I have had pink eye. My eyes are not strong yet. Dorothy is looking fine. I lost four days of school the first week in January. We had a rousing snowstorm yesterday, but I got to school by taking the trolley.

February 10, 1925 Dear Dad,

We are alive and well and it is thawing. The fog today has been thick enough to cut and part of the time it has rained. I did not miss a day because of bad

weather, though one morning I was quite late.

Our hens are beginning to lay now, got 34 today.

Burt had a letter from his mother. They sold \$300 worth of eggs last; feed cost \$90. They have about 500 hens. Burt has not worked for a few days, but started again today. They are building a barn.

Hope you are well and that your chickens are laying.

J.E. Austin, Hopewell Jct., N.Y., to Lillie Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y.

February 15, 1925 Dear Lillie,

Glad to hear you were all well. I see in the N.Y. paper the ice has gone out of the Hudson and Delaware Rivers. The rivers did quite a lot of damage in places on account of the ice damming up, but saw no account of any damage being done above the waters on the Delaware.

It's about time your hens began to lay eggs. We took a crate of eggs to Poughkeepsie yesterday and only got 48 cents a dozen. The most we got for eggs was \$1 per dozen. Our best month for the hens was December with \$65 clear for about 187 hens. 100 of the hens about paid for their feed in December. I have not heard from Mort since November. Hoping you are all well. With love, Dad

Mort Austin, Eldred, to Mr. J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.

February 20, 1925 Dear Brother,

I received your valentine yesterday. I have been going to write you for sometime, but have been busy. We are having a very good winter and are all feeling well. I will write you a letter soon. With love from all, Mort

Lillie Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y., to J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.

March 1, 1925 Dear Dad,

Thanks for the box of fruit and candy.

Burt has had the grippe. Just as he was getting over it, Dorothy had three days of croup. Last night she came down with grippe, not very bad. She's pretty good today, but was burning with fever last night.

Hannah came back last night to look after Dorothy while I am in school. I have 13 weeks and four days to teach yet. I do not think I shall teach next year. This teaching all day, nursing all night, and working Saturdays and Sundays is too much like work, and I've done a lot of it all since Xmas.

We are making our hens lay with an ax. That being the only way in which they will lay. Dorothy and Hannah have been working crossword puzzles.

Hope you keep well. With love, Lillie

Jennie Austin, Eldred, to Raymond Austin, Staten Island Friday noon, April 1925

Dear Ray,

We all have been straining our eyes in looking for a letter from you.

I have been going to write and ask you to go and call on Dr. Smith. He has had an operation in some hospital in the city, this morning. I called up his residence and Edith Pelton was there. I think she said he expected to leave the hospital today, but they wanted to get a room in Aunt Christina's neighborhood for a few days before undertaking the trip home. She said if you called up Aunt Christina she could tell you where to find him.

So if you have time Sunday, it would be nice for you to look him up and take him some corn cob pipes and tobacco and Mrs. Smith some flowers, but of course the flowers would not be necessary.

It is reported one of Eldred's widows with six children is to marry one of our widowers with seven children, but his children are all grown up, so she has the best of it.

The boys are getting along fine in school. The boys in Bob's class tried to smoke one day, but fortunately it was after school and Bob had come home before the boys got hold of the tobacco. Archie Von Ohlen said afterward that his mother was going to give him something nice if he didn't smoke again until he was 19, but the poor Parker boys, their mother didn't wait at all and from the sound, it wasn't very nice.

Well, try and write soon and take care and not to catch cold for it is good pneumonia weather. Lovingly, Mother

John E. Hill Marries Harriet Classen Eldridge

The wedding Jennie Austin referred to took place on April 10, 1925. John Edward Hill, the

widower with seven children, married Harriet Classen Eldridge, the widow with six children. These two families play a part in this story.

Jennie Austin, Eldred, to C.R. Austin, Staten Island 6 a.m. Monday, April 1925 My Dear Raymond,

I wonder if you realize that we have not heard from you since you were home in February, so it is time you should spare a few moments and write to us. The reason for writing so early in the morning is that I have just got Bill off to work. They are building another dam on the Mongaup stream and about 35 men from this side of Mongaup go over nearly every morning.

Harold Dunlap is married. The event happened on Easter Sunday [April 12, 1925]. The first day he went back to work he was nearly killed by a large

branch falling on him. Quite a few of the Eldred boys have met with accidents over there. None serious.

As yet, Clinton Leavenworth [Raymond's cousin] cut his foot quite badly and they took him to Port Jervis to have it attended to, but then they are working nearer Port than home.

Mrs. Tuzza, Nettie, Margaret, Anna, and a friend were up for the Easter week. It really seemed good to have them for we could or had to get out of our winter rut of living.

It keeps very cool and we still have snow and ice in spots. Now try and send us a letter within a day or so as we cannot help but feel anxious at times.

Wed. morning, April 22, 1925 Dear Raymond,

We have not heard from you in quite some time. Now I am writing by request of Mrs. Hattie Liebla in regards of the soldiers' bonus. She wanted me to find out

if you could get her a blank to fill out.

I think you stated you had wrote to Washington D.C. to find out the details, but now I think it

would be to Albany where your Bonus came from as this is a state and now a Federal bonus. Do what you can anyway.

We thought we would use Mac's bonus to pay for the markers for his and Elizabeth's graves which we expect soon, having been uneasy about ordering them, but likely some other way of paying will turn up.

We are having the house painted and will certainly look like a different place.

So far the prospects for the summer appear good. Am up to my neck in house cleaning.

The boys have a bicycle so have falls and fights galore.

Lillie Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y., to Mr. J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.

April 27, 1925 Dear Dad,

Was going to write you today, but have had a splitting headache all day. Better tonight.

Thank you for the fruit. Mother and I were alone when it came. The kids were on their Easter vacation. Burt has gone up home to look after the spring work. Dale is with him.

I expect Burt down Tuesday and we will move up Wednesday. Mother went up last Monday. Dorothy is with me.

We will take a couple of furnished rooms till my school closes.

Will come and see you some Saturday in May.

At his mother's request, Raymond did write regarding the information on compensation for McKinley from his death in WWI and Jennie received a response and a form in May.

War Department, to Mrs. C.M. Austin. Eldred

May 18, 1925 Dear Madam:

I am in receipt of a letter of April 29, 1925, from Mr. Charles R. Austin, Staten Island, N.Y., requesting that you be advised of the necessary steps to obtain compensation for deceased veterans of the World War.

The World War Adjusted
Compensation Act provides that
if a veteran died without making
application for the benefits
thereof, his compensation will be
payable only to his dependents
and in the following order of
preference: Unmarried widow,
children, mother, father. If the
dependent is a father or mother
the law requires that a statement
of dependency under oath be
submitted.

I am enclosing a blank application form with instructions for the dependent of Mr. Austin who is entitled to apply and upon its receipt in this office, it will be given prompt consideration.

Ell Austin continued to board at the home of Mrs. Forman and Mrs. Cole, and helped them out with home maintenance.

Lillie and Dorothy Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y., to J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.

May 19, 1925 Dear Dad.

If it is a nice day next Saturday, Dorothy and I will be down and stay all night since Mrs. Forman is kind enough to ask us.

My school will be out June 5th and I want to go home on the 6th. They have 1,000 baby chicks up home. Dale sprained his ankle and Burt is having

trouble with his rupture. There is a new bus line from Newburgh and Bloomingburg. You can go from New Paltz to Monticello now for \$1.81 if you go by train to Montgomery or \$2.30 all the way by bus by way of Newburgh. We are going back by Kingston on account of my trunk.

I am sorry you are having such bad luck with your chicks. With love. Lillie

Dear Grandpa.

We are coming down next Saturday if it is a nice day. We went home last Friday. Daddy sent for 1,000 little chicks, white ones. He lost a few. Hannah has got a new Chevrolet car. I got more to write about, but have no more room to write it, so will close.

Love from Dorothy

Burt Calkin Bethel, to Lillie *May 24, 1925*

Dear Lillie,

It is raining hard up here, has all day. I went to Eldred yesterday with hay. I took three loads down. Now I got a check of \$113 for it and have about three more loads to take. I saw Dave Crandall. He wants us to come and see him. He said that George and Jennie would not speak to him and he did not want us to go back on him. I told him he done just right if he felt that way.

Did you go to Hopewell Junction today? Our chicks are doing fine...With Love, Burt

Dave Crandall was the father of George Crandall, Jennie's husband. Dave's wife (George's mother) Sarah had died in 1924. Jennie and Lillie continued to be best of friends. Burt Calkin sounds like a peacemaker from the letter. Burt also wrote to his daughter.

Burt Calkin, Bethel, to Dorothy Calkin

May 25, 1925 Dear Dorothy,

How are you getting along? Did you go to see Granddad? Does it rain down there? We had a hard shower last night. Dale and I was coming home from Eldred. It has rained ever since.

You and Mother will soon be home now. I hope so, don't you?

The little chickens felt awful bad today. They had to stay in all day and they did not like it.

I haven't got a cow yet. I think I will go down and see how the chicks are. With love, Daddy

Lillie Calkin, New Paltz, N.Y. to, J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y.

May 26, 1925 Dear Dad,

We got here safely on the next to the last trolley at about seven o'clock. I think you have struck a place in a thousand. They [Mrs. Forman and Mrs. Cole] are certainly fine people. How are the chickens? I hope you have better luck than with the others.

I had a letter from home last night. The chicks are doing well, they say. I hope we are able to raise 500 pullets, but that is rather too much to expect.

I'm going to write a "thank you" to Mrs. Forman and then tackle my school work.

Lillie Calkin, Bethel, to J.E. Austin, Hopewell Junction, N.Y. *July 2, 1925*

Dear Dad,

If I were to hunt much longer for the ink, I wouldn't get any letter written tonight, so I guess I'll use pencil. We came home on the 6th of June.

We get up at 5 or 6 in the morning and go just as hard and fast as we can until 8 or 9, generally 9. I am keeping very well though, save that I have been 'enjoying" an ulcerating tooth, which is about well now.

The chickens have done very well—probably lost about 150 from various causes. We sold 120 roosters tonight. So many of ours seem to be pullets. It seems likely that we will have 450 or 500 of them. It's too bad you had such bad luck with yours. I think the yards must be infected.

Our garden is fine this year. We have had onions, radish, lettuce, turnips, and we have chard and peas big enough to use.

We set out about 500 cabbages. Our sweet cherries bore only a few. We will have quite a good many plums and peaches too as well as some grapes, also a good many raspberries and blackberries.

Burt is building a new porch. He tore down the old one. This one is 10 feet by 35 feet. Mother has had her house painted gray with white trim. It looks fine; also a new chimney laid in the sitting room from the cellar up. Her roomers are there this summer.

Malcolm Hadden lost all his cows in the TB test except three or four young heifers. Harry Tyler lost all or nearly all his.

I am going to teach again next winter in Fosterdale.

Burt bought a three-yearold heifer from Julius Maier this spring. She is certainly a dandy. Gives six to eight quarts at a milking, very rich.

We use all the cream we want. Dorothy drinks a small cup every meal. We use it on cereals, berries, lettuce, coffee, etc. We have all the butter we want for mother and ourselves and I hope to have one to five pounds a week to sell. Mrs. Schneider wants all the sweet butter I can make. Don't you think that is a pretty good heifer?

I am going to make currant jelly and jam and sour cherries tomorrow. Remember me to Mrs.

Isaac Bradley Letter

Isaac M. Bradley on the west side of Eldred wrote to his daughter Amelia Gregory who lived with her daughter Hazel Leavenworth Koenig in Wisconsin. Her other daughter Lottie Andeway lived, or soon would live, in Iowa.

Isaac M. Bradley, Eldred, to Amelia Gregory, Wisconsin July 8, 1925

Dear daughter and family,

I have hurd from you and yours several times since I have written. Will say I am a lisey [lazy] man!

As a family we are well. Lottie C. [his daughter] is as well as she has been. I think all the rest are OK. Averys [run the Bradley boarding house] have 40 guests and they have a man cook. He has only been here about four days and so far he suits me and should suit anyone!...I begin to feel old this year. You see, I have three great-grandchildren born

Using her interest in research (with the help of the internet) and the family collections that were soon shared, Louise began to compile the story of her grandparents and their ancestors.






Grandma and Me


Book 1: The Mill on Halfway Brook

The Mill on Halfway Brook tells of the Eldred, Austin, Myers, and Leavenworth families, their neighbors, friends, and kinsfolk that settled in what was once the Town of Lumberland, in the villages of Halfway Brook (Eldred), The River (Barryville), Ten Mile River (Tusten), and South Lebanon (Glen Spey).

The narrative weaves vignettes of townsfolk, preachers, churches, regional and national events with historical information, land documents, censuses, an 1875 biography, Congregational and Methodist Church records, over 300 photos and postcards, old and new maps, and at least 200 family letters (1845–1880).

The Mill on Halfway Brook is fully indexed with names of over 900 people, places, and events. It is the first in the series, Memoirs from Eldred, New York, 1800–1950.

Book 2: Echo Hill and Mountain Grove

Jennie Louisa Leavenworth and her future husband Charles Mortimer Austin lived near brooks on opposite sides of the charming village of Eldred, Town of Highland, Sullivan County, New York. The Leavenworth home near Blind Pond Brook on the west, would become Echo Hill Farm House. The Austin family would build Mountain Grove House near Halfway Brook, on the east side.

Echo Hill and Mountain Grove is an account of the change from lumbering, rafting, and bluestone quarrying to that of running boarding houses in the picturesque and healthy hamlets of Barryville, Minisink Ford, Yulan, Eldred, and Venoge, located near the Delaware River. It tells the history of the Town of Highland and its townsfolk (Austin, Leavenworth, Eldred, Myers, Bodine, Bradley, Bosch, Clark, Gardner, Hallock, Mills, Boyd, Horton, Parker, Greig, Stege, Sergeant, Tether, and others), many of whom owned boarding houses.

Echo Hill and Mountain Grove is bursting with anecdotes and stories of townsfolk, boarding houses, occupations, and events in the years 1880 to 1920. It includes visits to Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, New York City, and France. The narrative also gives details on the Shohola Depot, Shohola Glen, Shohola House, the Pelton Soda Factory, the Roebling Bridge, the Congregational Church Centennial, Zane Grey, two presidential assassinations, and World War I.

Echo Hill and Mountain Grove contains almost 900 images (photos, postcards, documents), several first person accounts, an 1881 Diary, 446 letters (150 WWI letters, including some from Lone Scout readers in 1918), nine original maps, and an index of 1,500 people, places, and events. It is the second book in the series, *Memoirs from Eldred, New York, 1800–1950*.
